

Sons & Daughters

This session kicks off a series called 'Sons and Daughters' exploring our identity as children of God. We'll look at how being part of God's family gives us purpose that transcends our circumstances. Using Abraham's story as an example, he shows how God can work through anyone to bless others, regardless of their situation. Our purpose isn't dictated by external circumstances, but comes from what God wants to do through us as His children.

LEARN

1. How does seeing yourself as a child of God change your perspective on your purpose in life?
2. What circumstances in your life have made you question your purpose?
3. How can we maintain a sense of purpose even when our circumstances are difficult?
4. In what ways can you be a blessing to others in your current situation?
5. How does Abraham's story encourage you in your own journey of faith and purpose?
6. What does it mean to you personally to be part of God's family?
7. How can we help each other live out our purpose as children of God?
8. What practical steps can you take this week to live out your purpose of blessing others?

APPLY

This week, identify three people in your immediate sphere of influence (family, friends, coworkers) and intentionally find ways to be a blessing to them. Keep a journal of how God works through these interactions and what you learn about living out your purpose as His child.
